Your business has been identified by Kent Fire Prevention as requiring a key box. In order for the Kent Fire Department to gain access to secured openings 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, you need to purchase a key box from the City of Kent specifically keyed for the Kent Fire Department.

- Medical** – Provided to assist with fire department access to residences during emergency medical situations.
- Low Security** – Gates and access to outside sprinkler “doghouses” will be allowed to use the low security model key box.
- Surface Safe #3266** – If construction has been completed, buildings will have the high security, surface mounted, key box installed.
- Recessed Safe #3275** – All new construction will be required to have the high security, recessed mounted, key box installed.
- Tamper Switch** – For an additional charge a tamper switch can be added to a key box.

- The address of the building where the box will be mounted

After you have installed your key box, call Fire Prevention at 253-856-4400 to schedule an inspection to lock the front plate. Provide a contact name and phone number of the individual that will give the Inspector the key(s) at the site.

If you re-key your facility be sure to call and schedule another inspection.
