## Abandoned Car Recovered from Green River

**Kent, Wash. - April 18, 2016** - A vehicle found on the bottom of the Green River is being brought to the shore after divers determined that no one was in it.

The small, white car was reported to 9-1-1 at 2:10 this afternoon in the 25000 block of Frager Road. It is unknown where or when the car entered the water. Debris on the roof indicated that it may have been submerged for a significant amount of time. Possible reasons for no one noticing the vehicle could be the lack of clarity of the water or the high water level.

The King County Sheriff's Office's dive team will hook up a tow cable and remove the car in the next hour.

In addition to the Kent RFA, the following agencies responded to the call: King County Medic One, the Renton Fire Department, Valley Regional Fire Authority, and the Zone 3 Explorers.
