## House Fire Displaces Four

SeaTac, Wash. - August 4, 2015- Four people have been displaced following a house fire in the 3400 block of S. 191 Street.

Three of the people were home at the time of the fire and all were able to escape safely. When firefighters from the Kent Fire Department RFA arrived, they found the entire second floor of the house engulfed in flames. By quickly attacking the fire the initial units were able to keep it from spreading to nearby houses and shrubs.

Despite getting water on the flames quickly, much of the second floor was gutted by the fire.

In addition to the Kent Fire Department RFA, firefighters from South King Fire and Rescue, and the Burien FD also responded. Zone 3 Fire Explorers and King County Medic One provided rehabilitation.

There were no reports of injuries and Red Cross has been called in to assist the family.

The fire is currently under investigation.
