## **Bull Pen Bar and Grill Damaged by Fire**

SeaTac, Wash. - August 23, 2016- A SeaTac landmark, the Bull Pen Bar and Grill, was damaged by a fire this evening. The restaurant is located on the 20000 block of International Boulevard and the business was open when a staff member first noticed smoke and dialed 911 at approximately 6:17 PM. Subsequent calls were made by motorists passing by the establishment.

On arrival firefighters found the business evacuated with heavy smoke coming from the roof. Firefighters from Kent Regional Fire Authority, South King Fire and Rescue, Tukwila Fire, Burien Fire, Port of Seattle and King County Medic 1 responded and were able to make a quick stop and thus limited the fire's damage.

All staff and customers were able to safely evacuate the establishment and there were no injuries reported by firefighters.

Early indications point toward the fire's cause as being accidental, however, the investigation is still ongoing. At this time there is no damage estimate.
