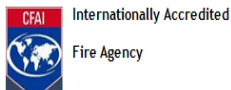

Small Smoky Fire at “Packing Peanut” Plant in Kent

Kent, Wash. - August 31, 2015- A smoky fire at a “packing peanut” plant in Kent caused the evacuation of the building early this afternoon. The fire, at the plant located in the 20400 block of 87 Avenue S, was confined to the mechanical equipment used in the manufacture and packaging of “packing peanuts”. The fire was quickly extinguished by the Kent firefighters. The smoke in the building was pushed out of the building by the fire department’s ventilation fans. The smoky fire caused approximately \$30,000 in damages to the manufacturing equipment only.

No reports of injuries to employees of the business or firefighters were reported.
