## SeaTac House Fire

**SeaTac, Wash. - September 29, 2016-** The owner of a small, single story house was able to escape safely after her house caught fire at 5:50 pm, in the 2400 block of S. 132 Street.

Firefighters from the Kent RFA, which is contracted with the City of SeaTac, the Tukwila FD, North Highline FD, Burien FD, and the Port of Seattle, responded to the call. When the first units arrived, they found smoke and flames coming from two sides of the house. It took firefighters approximately 20 minutes to fully extinguish the fire, which started in a front room of the house. A cat died in the fire, but there were no other reported injuries.

No other homes were affected.

The Zone 3 Fire Explorers and King County Medic One provided medical support and rehabilitation for firefighters at the scene.

The fire is currently under investigation.
