## Commercial Building Fire

**Kent, Wash. - October 10, 2016-** The cause of a fire in the 200 block of E. Morton Street has been ruled "undetermined" tonight after it gutted an abandoned, two-story building.

Firefighters from the Kent RFA were dispatched shortly before midnight to an unused commercial building that was being lived in by transients. A roofing business had previously occupied it.

When they arrived on scene they found the building fully engulfed in flames. The fire was fought from the outside due to the amount of fire damage and possibility of collapse.

There were no reports of injuries and no one was found near the structure.

Fire investigators will not be able to enter the building due to the amount of damage. Firefighters will remain on scene through the night to watch for any hidden fires.

In addition to the Kent RFA, King County Medic One, Zone 3 Fire Explorers, and Kent Police also responded to the incident.
