Kent House Fire

Kent, Wash. - November 5, 2015- A fire at 9:00 PM in the 24300 block of 129 Ave. SE has been ruled accidental after an extension cord overheated and ignited an SUV in the driveway of a two-story house.

The call was initially dispatched as a vehicle fire, but was upgraded to a residential fire after multiple calls to 9-1-1 reported that the flames had spread to the attached garage and shake roof. Everyone in the home was able to escape safely and there were no reports of injuries.

Firefighters from the Kent Regional Fire Authority quickly extinguished the fire in the garage and vehicle, keeping it from spreading to the rest of the house.

Red Cross is assisting the family with housing.
