**Afternoon House Fire**  
Displaces three adults and a dog

**Kent, Wash. November 19, 2015-** Just after 2 PM, Kent and Renton fire crews were dispatched to a residential fire on the 13300 block of SE 195 Street in Renton. According to the first fire engine on scene, flames could be seen coming out of a second floor window of the two story house. That same crew initially knocked down the fire from the outside as they made their way in. At the same time, a search of the house came up clear. Because of the quick fire attack, most of the damage was limited to the upper level.

The home owners were walking their dog when they returned home to find smoke coming from the house and smoke alarms sounding. They realized that there was indeed a fire and immediately called 911. There are a total of three residents and their dog who are now displaced by the fire.

The Kent Regional Fire Authority, Renton Fire Department, King County Medic One, King County Fire Investigator, King County Sheriff's Office, Zone 3 Rehabilitation, and Puget Sound Energy were all on scene.

There are no injuries to report. The King County Fire Investigator and Kent RFA Fire Investigator are currently on scene to try to determine cause. The damage report is estimated at \$110,000.
