Kent West Hill Commercial Fire

Kent, Wash. December 9, 2015 - At 8:16 this evening, fire units were dispatched to a commercial fire on the 25900 block of Pacific Highway South in Kent. The first arriving units found light smoke coming from a corner of the building along with employees and customers out in the parking lot. Shortly after, the call was upgraded to a "working" fire which allowed more resources to be added for help at the fire. Searches of the business assured that no one was left inside, power to the building was shut off for safety, and both medical and rehabilitation units were on scene to assist as needed.

Firefighters were able to attack the fire from the outside of the building and quickly subdued the fire. After a thorough search for hot spots, the fire was considered completely out by 9 PM.

Responding agencies were Kent Regional Fire Authority, South King Fire Rescue, King County Medic One, Zone 3 Rehabilitation Unit, Kent Police Department, and Puget Sound Energy.

The Kent RFA Fire Investigator ruled the fire to be "Undetermined Accidental". There are no injuries to report. There is no damage estimate at this time.
