Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, April 12, 2018

Business:

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- Contract for service feasibility update: Chief Tyerman provided a PowerPoint presentation on the budget numbers for contracting for services. A discussion was held on the costs of covering firefighters assigned at the Maple Valley stations while on disability, the costs for each admin position and the apparatus and ownership if there were damage incurred. Chief Tyerman stated the best practice is quarterly payments. Commissioner Walls asked for the mileage of each apparatus. Chairperson Bodlovic asked for the 2024-year budget of standing alone. Commissioner Hayman asked about the Local contract negotiations, the process, members involved costs, etc. Commissioner Herbert asked for clarity on the apparatus surplus and reserves. Commissioner Walls would like to speak with the other commissioners. Chairperson Bodlovic asked for the next steps in this process. Chief Tyerman asked if there was anything specific requested for the contract. Chairperson Bodlovic asked several questions. Chief Tyerman will work on the contract details and the administrative framework of District 43. Commissioner Herbert asked about the milestones needed in the timeline to contract for services. Chief Tyerman will present the contract details, administrative framework, and timeline at the next meeting. A question was asked about the succession of the Fire Chief. There will be a plan in place for backup when needed. Commissioner Hayman asked for concerns from the employees about contracting for services. BC Bille, and FF Knowles provided their insight. Commissioner Walls asked for the comparison of contracting versus stand alone with lid lifts.
- <u>Personal Service Contracts:</u> Fire Marshal Webster, Chief Tyerman, and Deputy Chief DiDonato had their contracts updated for consistency and language corrections. Commissioner Herbert and Hayman provided their comments of the negotiation meeting. A MOTION was made, seconded and unanimously carried to approve the Personal Services Contracts for Fire Marshal Webster, Chief Tyerman, and Deputy Chief DiDonato.
- Resolution 2018-005 Visa Increase: Increase the VISA limit from \$10,000 to \$20,000. A MOTION was made, seconded and unanimously carried to approve the Resolution R-2018-005.
- <u>King County Automatic Aid ILA:</u> Seattle Fire Chief is working on a countywide automatic aid. This ILA is to drop the zone borders. Chairperson Bodlovic signed the authorization. A MOTION was made, seconded and unanimously carried to approve the Martin Luther King County Automatic Aid ILA.
- <u>Land Developed next to 83:</u> A housing development is in process for 46 homes next to station 83. A discussion took place regarding the future growth and services needed from MVFD.
