APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR RETAIL SALE OF FIREWORKS

- A **State Fire Marshal's License** for retail sale of fireworks must be obtained from:

Insurance Building
Olympia, WA 98501

Two copies of the State Fire Marshal's License will be submitted with the permit application. The license will be posted on site, **after** being signed by an inspector from the City of Covington Fire Marshal's Office.

- **Proof of insurance coverage** as specified in RCW 70.74
- A **Site Plan** of the proposed location of the fireworks stand shall be drawn to scale on an 8.5 x 11" diagram. This diagram shall show the size of the stand; distance from the stand to structures, buildings, fire hydrants, other stands, streets, and parking areas.

The Fireworks Permit Fee of \$100.00 must be submitted with the application.

- **Written Authorization** from the property owner which allow use of the site.

The completed application package must be submitted to the City of Covington Permit Services Center no later than June 13th. ***Any application received after June 13th will not be approved.*** Packets may be mailed or delivered in person.

The Fireworks Permit will be issued to the applicant at the time of inspection of the fireworks stand. The location of the stand shall be as shown on the approved site plan.

The Applicant/Contact Person (as listed on the application) will be notified when a Permit application is approved.

Approved and licensed fireworks stands are subject to inspection during periods of operation. Strict adherence to established rules and regulations is mandatory.
