Single Bedroom Fire in Kent Home

Kent, Wash – June 26, 2017 – Smoke alarms woke up a family to an electrical fire in the master bedroom on the 24600 block of 101st Place. The resident's used a fire extinguisher but the fire continued to grow and so evacuated the home and called 911.

Puget Sound Fire units were dispatched at 12:18AM and were soon on location. Due to the quick actions of Fire Engine 74 the fire was held to the master bedroom.

Residents are receiving help from the American Red Cross as the smoke damage was throughout the upstairs sleeping areas.

In addition to Puget Sound Fire Units, South King County Medic One responded to check the family members and provide support to the fire crews.

The family was grateful the smoke alarms woke them to the fire danger.
