Fire in SeaTac home being remodeled

SeaTac, Wash – April 20th, 2018 – At 5:52 this morning a fire was called in at the 13600 block of Military Road South.

The first arriving Fire engine saw heavy smoke coming from the home. It was obvious from the demolition debris on the front yard and missing windows that the home was under remodel. The interior of the home was not sheet rocked and so the fire was quickly extinguished.

As the fire was being put out, additional crews did a thorough search for individuals who may have been using the home as a place to sleep for the evening. Fortunately, no one was found and no firefighter was injured.

Units from Burien/Normandy Park, Highline, and Tukwila responded with Puget Sound Fire.

South King County Medic One arrived to assist the fire units in case of a medical concern.

Cause of the fire is under investigation at this time by Puget Sound Fire Investigators.
