SeaTac House Fire

SeaTac, Wash – November 8, 2018 – A dog woke and warned his owner early this morning after the man’s house caught fire in the 2600 block of S. 138 Street.

Both were able to get out of the single-story home safely shortly after 3:00 am and call 911.

When firefighters Puget Sound Fire arrived, they found heavy smoke and fire coming from the front and back of the house. After going into the house to fight the flames initially, firefighters were forced to move back outside due to the amount of fire and possibility of the roof collapsing.

Currently, crews are extinguishing hot spots in the attic and living spaces.

A Puget Sound Fire Investigator is on scene to determine the fire’s cause and Red Cross is assisting the home owner.

Washington Water Damage is providing a free board up service to secure and protect the house.
