Kent East Hill Attic Fire

Kent, Wash – November 23, 2018 – A two story home suffered major fire damage in the attic space in the 21300 block of 104 Pl SE.

At 1:27 PM the lady of the home saw fire in the master bath ceiling fan and with her family safely made it out of the home. Once outside, 911 was called and Puget Sound Regional and Renton Regional Fire units responded.

Puget Sound's Fire Engine 77 was first on scene and made a quick attack into the home while Ladder 74, with Renton's Aid 18 assistance, laddered the roof and cut a hole allowing water to hit all areas of the attic fire.

The quick actions of the fire crews kept the fire to one area of the home and attic space.

Medic One checked the family members and Zone Three rehab provide assistance to the firefighters.

The "Board up Company" is providing a free service to the family to secure the home from rain.

A special thanks to the American Red Cross who is assisting the family during this difficult time.

At time of press release, the fire is still under investigation by a Puget Sound fire investigator.
