### **Apartment Fire on Kent Kangley**

Kent, Wash – January 16, 2019 – At 7:27 AM a fire started in the kitchen of a ground floor apartment at the 11300 block of SE Kent Kangley Road.

Residents were able to quickly evacuate before the fire spread into their living room.

Puget Sound Fire Engine 74 arrived and with flames coming out of the front door made entry and extinguished the fire, keeping it to the single unit. The units above and surrounding the fire unit sustained minor smoke damage.

The residents of the fire unit were unharmed and are receiving assistance from the American Red Cross. The management team of the complex will also be helping by securing the fire unit and offering another unit in the complex for the family to move into.

South King County Medic One did a through exam of the residents, of the fire unit, and determined there were no medical concerns.

Puget Sound Fire Department was able to control and extinguish the fire without requesting outside agencies help.
