Condo Building Fire Displaces Over 30 People

SeaTac, Wash – March 9, 2019 – A fire in the 3400 block of S. 176 Street has displaced over 30 people.

The fire was first reported by residents in the two-story townhomes/condos at 8:00 pm last night. When firefighters arrived, they found smoke and flames from several second story windows and the roof. A second-alarm was issued to bring additional resources to the scene.

Firefighters battled the flames for an hour before being able to fully extinguish the fire, limiting the fire to the unit where it started and a portion of the attic space. Several of the connected homes suffered smoke and water damage.

Electrical power has been shut off by PSE due to exposed wiring shorting out. This has forced the temporary removal of all occupants of the building.

Red Cross is assisting the displaced families with housing and other needs. There were no reported injuries.

This fire was caused by unattended cooking and is considered accidental.
