Kent House Fire

Kent, Wash – June 10, 2019 – A Puget Sound RFA investigator is working to determine what started a house fire in the 10500 block of SE 236 Place.

The fire was first reported at 12:43 pm. When firefighters arrived, there were large amounts of fire and smoke from the back of the two-story house. Fire had entered both floors through glass sliders and had also gotten into the attic space through the bird blocking.

Only one of the six residents were home at the time of the fire. There were no reported injuries.

Red Cross is assisting the residents and the Flood Guys are providing a free board-up service to protect the occupant's property.
