Maple Valley Doublewide fire

Maple Valley, Wash – Nov. 17, 2019 – At 10:40 Puget Sound Fire units responded to the 27400 block of 220th Pl SE for a double-wide mobile home fire.

The older gentleman saw a flame at the home medical oxygen bottle in the home and quickly helped his wife evacuate. 911 was then called and Puget Sound Fire Engine 380 arrived and found flames coming from the front door and broken living room window.

A fire hose was quickly extended, and an exterior fire attack began knocking down the fire. With additional Puget Sound Fire units on scene E380 was able to make entry and extinguish the rest of the flames.

Sadly, due to the rapid growth of the fire the couple lost their small dog and cat to smoke inhalation.

South King County Medic One was one scene and checked the couple for injuries and then stood by for fire fighter safety.

American Red cross is assisting the displaced couple and BELFOR a board up company is providing a free service of securing the home.

King County Fir Marshal has ruled the fire to be accidental and the dollar loss is yet to be determined.
