Disaster Preparedness

The CERT members' role in disaster response, hazards most likely to affect the community and how to prepare.

Disaster Fire Extinguishment

To reduce fire risks and engage in limited fire extinguishment using basic safety precautions.

Disaster Medical Operations

How to manage airway obstruction, excessive bleeding, treatment of wounds and shock in disaster victims and methods of prioritizing and treating multiple patients.

Search & Rescue

To safely search a structure; debris removal; victim extrication and rescuer protection.

Disaster Psychology

To identify and relieve post-disaster emotional stressors in rescuers and survivors.

Team Organization

How to organize and function as a team with other CERT members during a disaster.
