



## **Festival and Food Vendor Requirements**

- Cooking Tents shall be placed at the front edge of the parking stalls.
- Combustible materials such as hay, straw, shavings, or similar material are prohibited inside tents.
- Smoking is prohibited inside tents and or food trucks, NO SMOKING signs must be posted by each vendor.
- Open flame or other devices emitting flame are prohibited inside a tent including cooking devices utilizing gas, charcoal, or wood.
- Open flame and cooking devices that emit flame or sparks shall be located behind the tents.
- Cooking devices that emit grease-laden vapors such as deep fryers, pizza ovens, etc. are allowed inside a tent.
- Fireworks are prohibited.
- A 2A:10BC portable fire extinguisher is required for each vendor.
- A Class K portable fire extinguisher is required for each vendor conducting cooking operations.
- Food warming, cooking demonstrations and similar operations using solid flammables, butane or other similar devices are allowed under a tent.
- Cooking tents with sidewalls or drops shall be separated from other tents by not less than 20 feet.
- LP-gas containers shall be located outside of tents.
- LP-gas containers shall be secured so that they cannot tip over.
- LP-gas container safety release valves shall be pointed away from tents.
- LP-gas containers shall not be located within 10 feet of any tent.
- Flammable and or combustible liquids are prohibited.
- Food trucks containing hood and duct systems must display current cleaning certificate as well as current fire suppression certificate.
- Generators must be 20 feet from tents. No more than 5 gallons of gas in proper containers for refueling can be on site.
- Refueling generators must be 100 feet from any tent.
- Canopies shall be located a minimum of 20 feet from any building or structure. The aggregate area of multiple tents placed side by side without a fire break clearance of 12 feet is not to exceed 700 square feet. (7 tents)
- All electrical cords shall be properly sized and protected from damage.
- Bouncy houses and other inflatables must be secured to ground by approved means.
